A NEW LANDMARK IN MELLIEHA

It has been two years since starting our new club building project, having put in a large amount of voluntary working hours and seeing the project take shape, it has been a very interesting time. The idea that was forged many years ago to have a permanent choir and orchestra in our town was not taken lightly. In 1947 a group of young musicians put their ideas on the line and formed a local organisation that would encourage their musical talents and to be of service to the Mellieha community.



Over the years, moving from one place to another, our Society finally bought its own premises in 1991. In 2002 the opportunity arose to buy the adjacent property and so our Choral and Orchestral Society could continue what was started in 1995 in expanding musical education to a greater number of students wishing to sit for examinations by the Associated Board of the Royal Schools of Music. With the number of musicians and students ever increasing, it was only time that we should put our heads together and plan for premises that would be of use to the same members and others who have

music at heart. These past years have seen many sacrifices by many who have been involved in our society, not only in the actual construction but also in every department needed to keep our organisation functioning. Conscious that the core of who we are, being the Choir and Orchestra, could start to suffer due to lack of interest, over burdening or even not enough funds to keep our busy programme schedule on track, we have managed so far to keep a fine line in moving forward in all quarters. Our music students are our back bone, and are with the help of tutors and senior members, tomorrow's singers and musicians who will take this Society forward. It is this vision that has kept our momentum of further expansion at the top of our agenda. Every one knows that an organisation of this size needs adequate finances to keep in operation, not more so than now, with the building project in progress and the every day sums needed. We are very much indebted to all those who in any shape or form have contributed in any way to help us achieve our goals. This momentum must not be lost, we are always very much in need of volunteers, material and finances to rise to the challenges ahead.

We will not let you down. It is with these aims and qualities that I present the Committee, Musical Director, members, teachers, students and friends all coming together to form the Choral and Orchestral Society 'Maria Bambina'.
